Arts and Crafts Application 2010

The Durango Farmers Market is accepting applications for Arts & Crafts vendors. The Durango Farmers Market is seeking only the highest quality arts and crafts. Preference will be given to arts and crafts that relate to the Farmers Market through relation to: Food, Farm/Garden, Kitchen, and or Yard. Items may include, but are not limited to, hand woven baskets, dried flower arrangements, handspun and dyed wool, hand thrown pottery, hand made furniture, etc. All products to be sold at the market must be juried before the application is accepted. Space for arts and crafts vendors is limited to 3 booths per market. The Market begins in May and continues until sometime in October. The market begins promptly at 8 and ends at 12. You will be responsible for following all the Rules and Regulations of the Durango Farmers Market. Any questions should be addressed to Steve Van Buskirk. The DFM Board will jury the applications.

Eligibility

- Handmade, high quality crafts only.
- All arts and crafts sold at the market **must be handmade**.
- All booths must have a canopy. There will be no imported, mass produced, or manufactured goods accepted.
- The artist or craftsperson who made the work must be the attendant at the booth.
- All artists must be from the five county region: La Plata, Montezuma, Archuleta, San Juan, NM, and San Juan, CO
- All booths must look professional and include a canopy.
- Arts & Crafts booths must relate to the Farmers Market through association with the following: Food, Farm/Garden, Kitchen, and or Yard

All vendors are responsible for following the Rules and Regulations of the Durango Farmers Market. This includes the collection and reporting of applicable sales taxes for the State, County, and City. A City Business/Sales Tax License is required and must be on display at all times during the Market.

Application and Jury Requirements

- Please include photos of your crafts and/or art, one photo of the booth/display, along with this application. As time draws closer to the Market opening we will notify applicants by phone. All work submitted must be representative of what you plan to sell at the Market.
- All **applications** must be received no later than one week prior to the Market you would like to attend. Please send or drop off the Arts and Crafts application, along with **signed affidavit** to:
